



## Cabernet Sauvignon 2014

The First straight Cabernet Sauvignon from Castle Rock Estate for twenty years and is made from the original plantings in 1983 and 1986. Matured in French oak Barriques for 17 months this wine highlights Cabernet from the Great Southern off mature vines.

### ASSESSMENT

**Colour:** Deep red colour.

**Bouquet:** Rich and layered bouquet which shows blackberry and black current aromas, backed by hints of mint, tobacco leaf and cedary oak characters

**Palate:** The blackberry fruit characters fill the front palate, providing richness and generosity. The mid palate has depth and intensity with great balance between the fruit characters and a firm tannin structure. The subtle tobacco notes and cedary French oak are just perceivable, yet add layers to the palate and are integrated harmoniously. The finish is long and fine thanks to great balance between the tannin backbone and a fine acidity structure.

### FOOD ACCOMPANIMENT

An ideal accompaniment to red meats and hearty dishes. Will also go well with ripe cheeses at the end of a meal.

### CELLARING POTENTIAL

Will continue to improve and develop complexity with age; cellar for 10 to 15 years
